Walk around your garden, or park if safe to do so and see what birds you can see. Write down their name and what you think their favourite food is.



What pets do you have at home? Choose one (if you dont have a pet, choose a friend's) and daw it in the box below.





You cannot enjoy our maze just yet but, in the meantime, try this challenge and find your way to the middle.






